


1980 on








Sands & McDougall directories from 1870s. The original credit reference source.

Published annually – thus always 1 year out. Ceased publication late 1970s. Books became extremely thick – up to around 10" by the end! Microfiche at State Library & Preston Library. Invaluable resource. Lists by Suburb, street, trade & name index.







